From November, 27th to November, 30th AplusB Gallery hosts "Tracce Materiali", duo-show of Marco Chemello and Lorenzo Favaron, as part of the First Step project promoted by the Academy of Fine Arts of Verona. The exhibition is staged with the curatorial support of Veronica Pasetto, Marianna Perazzoli and Elisa Perina (tutor: Jessica Bianchera and Marta Ferretti). "Tracce Materiali" recounts the experience shared by the two artists, who simultaneously investigate natural and artificial, with different results; in particular, both in Favaron and in Chemello, the traces left by selected materials (wood on cement, larvae on the canvas) are clearly visible, intended as a result of the combination of natural and non-natural.

In the works of Marco Chemello entitled "Larvae paintings", the larvae, once used for fishing, are now immersed in oil paint and left free on the canvas so that with their movements they create paths that recall the painting of abstract expressionism movement, but where the ego of the artist is absent. Marco Chemello succeeds in impressing on the canvas emotions of his childhood, moods that arise from a search for virtual re-enactment - through the art - of the link now lost with his father.

By combining different materials, in his sculptures Lorenzo Favaron draws attention to the theme of nature: through the transformation of the elements and their metamorphosis, nature is constantly brought to its limit. Water, earth, air and fire react together and cooperate to the creation of cement-sculptures: the artist invites us to reflect on the relationship between natural and artificial.

"First Step" is a project promoted by the Academy of Fine Arts of Verona. Every year the most interesting researches of its young artists are presented in galleries and spaces present
