NAZZARENA POLI MARAMOTTI

Nazzarena Poli Maramotti is a genuine painter: her analysis explores the traditional subjects consistently portrait, landscape and still life -and investigates the possible relations between shape and color, tone and light, matter's density and lightness, experimented in the painting practice. Working with recurring subjects frees her from being worried about the content, allowing her to concentrate on the painting. Earlier in her career, around the years 2000, her research was on shape and portrait mainly, looking at historic and modern tradition, from the German Expressionism till Soutine, Bacon and Baselitz.

From the beginning of her career she is intolerant towards academic rigidity of mimesis: she sets herself apart from reality; physical features are partially deleted and become the excuse for an extraordinary and new pictorial sensibility where action, matter and color merge in a tangled combination. The artist overcomes the specific individual forming universal shapes that aim to grow and include the landscape, another field of pure painting action. By doing so, she crosses the boarder of different genres.









OSAMU KOBAYASHI

In Osamu Kobayashi's abstract paintings, large color planes form playful geometries to create a palpable sense of motion. These formally reductive yet spontaneous works can evoke technicolor landscape or surrealistic close-ups of the human body. Since receiving his BFA in 2006 from the Maryland Institute College of Art, Kobayashi has widely exhibited, with solo presentations in New York City, Miami, and Brescia, Italy. Kobayashi combines broad, sweeping brushstrokes and vivid color to divide his canvases. Evoking aura photography, his luminous paintings seem to capture unseen forces, exuding otherworldly energy.

Kobayashi's painting are simple in color and form, often comprised of two to three essential color. There are bisections and intersections, and floating shapes in ephemeral, glowing color fields in some cases, paint is applied thieckly, evokin our desire to touch. The forms are organic while remaining geometric, structured while at the same time stayin loos. His painigns are uncomplicated, but sophisticated explorations of the fundamental building blocks of design.



MARKUS SAILE

The works of Markus Saile suggest a change of medium with regard to painting. The line has become a trace. Paint has become turpentine. Painting has become unstable because turpentine, used to thin oil paint, has separated it from its undercoat, allowing it to slide, slip, fly across the smooth surface. The effect penetrates the eye and could have its counterpart there: fluff on retina. Moments of seeing which have nothing real and nothing unreal before them, but rather an indescribably fleeting, material something which appears to be very close.

The formats vary, are frequently small, often eye images, with only the larger ones as body images. Sometimes they act contrary to the idea of good picture proportions in painting, with shapes that are almost square or nearly DIN format. There is a chalk ground which creates a perpetually slippery surface. And at the same time this smooth surface produces a background radiance.

Tobias Hoffknecht

TOBIAS HOFFKNECHT

His drawings, the sculptural basis of his works, are subjected to a substractive process. By increasingly reducing the preliminary sketch, he creates a minimalist spatial layout, which then takes on the form of an installation. The combination of installation and sculpture emerges out of a conceptual analysis of sculptural activity within the drawing, with the intention of breaking down and breaking through the respective space.

Spatial references within the exhibition situation are witness to this symbiosis. Hoffknecht creates volumes through surfaces. Surfaces, which defer to the space, divide, usurp and break it. As a result, the space is created anew. Surfaces form the main components of the works in the exhibition "Rehearsal", which occupy the space with their clear and highly reduced formal language.


Tobias Hoffknecht Chamber, 2023 Steel and varnish, 150x80x66 cm euro 12000 IVA inc.




Tobias Hoffknecht Tender, 2023 Steel and varnish, 50x24x71 cm euro 7000 IVA inc.


